- Date:** Saturday, November 19, 2005
- Time/Race Distance:** Women's 6K 11:00 a.m.
Men's 10K 12:00 p.m.
- Site:** Prado Park, Chino, California
- Course Description:** The course is run on grass, equestrian trails, slight rolling hills with numerous turns and crossing of asphalt roads.
- Park Entrance/Parking** Team entrance/parking permits will be available at declaration and packet pick-up. Special team parking is available near the team camp area.
- Course Records:** Men: 10K – 32:51.4 Women: 6K – 20:54.3
- Location/Directions:** 14 miles southeast of Sheraton Fairplex.
1. Leave hotel, turn right going west on McKinley Ave. to Fairplex Ave.
2. Turn left on Fairplex Ave and go 2.8 miles to Holt Blvd.
3. Turn right on Holt Blvd. and go .01 miles (under 71 Fwy.) and turn right onto 71 Fwy. heading South.
4. Take 71 South for 11.8 miles.
5. Exit Butterfield Ranch Rd./Euclid Ave.
6. Turn left onto Euclid Ave. (Hwy 83).
7. Proceed East on Euclid Ave. for 1.4 miles to Prado Park. Entrance is on the right
- Entry:** Per 2005 NCAA CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP HANDBOOK. Available on NCAA Web Site: www2.ncaa.org. Call Coach Jim Sackett (909) 869-2831 if you haven't received the information.

- Declarations:** Final declarations must be made in person on Friday, November 18, from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at the Sheraton Fairplex Pavilions 1 & 2. Early declaration is designed to provide you with parking permits that will allow you free admission to the park on Friday and Saturday. This will help avoid Friday afternoon traffic in that area. All other days you will need to pay a \$5.00 per vehicle parking fee. Declaration packet will include parking permits, athletes' momentos, awards banquet tickets, pins and programs. Bib numbers will be issued at the technical meeting at 3:30 p.m.
- Coaches' Technical Meeting:** Mandatory technical meeting will be held on Friday at 3:30 p.m. at the Sheraton Fairplex in Salon D. A coaches association meeting will follow.
- Preview Course:** The course may be previewed on any day until the park closes at dusk. The best time to be on the course is between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4 p.m. to avoid traffic congestion.
- Facilities:** The park does have toilet facilities, but portable toilets will be in use with one grouping specifically in the team camp area and warm up/cool down area. No public telephones in the immediate area.
- Trainer:** Trainers are available daily at Cal Poly Pomona from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. Race day from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the course.
- Souvenirs:** Official NCAA souvenirs will be available on Friday from 9:00 a.m. to noon at Sheraton Fairplex, at the course and at the awards dinner until sold out.
- T-shirt exchange:** The student-athletes' t-shirt exchange will be held from 3 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at The Sheraton Fairplex lobby on Friday, Nov. 18.
- Awards:** Trophies will be presented to the top 4 teams and top 15 individuals at the Awards Banquet on Saturday evening, Nov. 19. The Cross Country Hall of Fame induction and the regional and national

Athletes and Coaches of the Year awards will also be given.

Team or individual reservations will only be taken after the Regional Championships. Reservations will be taken November 7, 2005 through November 10, 2005. After that time, rooms and rates will not be guaranteed. Reservations can be made between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Pacific Standard Time.

Group check-in time is 3 p.m. Earlier check-in arrangements must be made with the hotel. Check-out time is 12 p.m.
