Graduate Student Internship Proposal:

Each graduate student is required to fulfill 200 internship/practicum hours for the Master of Science in Regenerative Studies. Students are required to meet that requirement by fulfilling 100 intern/practicum hours at the Lyle Center and an additional 100 hours at the Lyle Center or in an off-site activity of their choice. Students may select a paid or volunteer position in a public agency, private business, or non-profit organization that engages them in some activity related to Regenerative Studies. The activity may be related to student's thesis, future employment goals, and/or an area of interest or knowledge. Students choosing the off-site internship are required to obtain approval from the Internship Coordinator before engaging in the proposed activity. This form is provided for student proposals.
