

Dawn Van Bruggen Memorial Scholarship

The Dawn Van Bruggen Memorial Scholarship was established by the Learning Resource Center after Dawn's sudden death on July 30, 1999, to honor this former LRC writing tutor who was an exceptional employee, a determined and involved student, as well as a good friend to all who knew her. She was energetic, hardworking, dependable, honest, and outgoing. Dawn was helpful to everyone she met, often meeting students late at night if that was their only available time. She was also a humble person who sought tutoring for her own difficult classes. In spite of the demands of school and work, Dawn also found time to volunteer with Disabled Student Services and the Rose Float Club. Furthermore, she considered her paid positions with Housing, Commencement, and the LRC to be more than just employment but also a way of giving service to the university. To keep her memory alive, this scholarship is given annually to a student who exemplifies Dawn's qualities and who has provided tutoring in the current academic year through the ASI Universitywide Tutoring Program, the College Reading Skills Program (CRSP), or the Upward Bound Program.

Recipient must be a Cal Poly Pomona undergraduate student who

- provided tutoring in ASI, CRSP or Upward Bound during the current academic year;
- has demonstrated perseverance through adversity;
- has qualities that Dawn possessed such as being helpful, friendly, goal oriented, hardworking, and dependable; and
- has provided university or community service.
