CORE COURSE FLOW CHART FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

The courses listed on the chart should be taken in the sequence shown. This three-year schedule is suited to transfer students who have many of their general education courses completed. All courses shown are four units, except URP 461, and URP 462 which are two units. See the course catalog for a listing of prerequisites. You must also complete 32 units of core electives during this period (subject to prerequisites), and up to 20 units of support courses depending on your GE coursework. Any remaining general education courses must be completed during this period. Note: Most classes are offered only once a year and have prerequisites, so taking the correct sequence is important.
