

Broncos Finish Fourth In Own Tourney

Azusa Pacific beats UC Davis to win 2004 California Invitational

POMONA — Cal Poly Pomona's men's tennis team fell to Abilene Christian in the third-place match, while Azusa Pacific defeated UC Davis, 8-1, to win the 2004 California Invitational Sunday at the Kellogg Tennis Complex. Azusa Pacific is the No.1-ranked NAIA men's tennis team in the country.

The Broncos fell to Abilene Christian, 6-3, in the match for third place. Cal Poly Pomona's David Nguyen (Sr., Los Angeles, Beverly Hills HS) completed a perfect tournament, winning again at No. 1 singles and doubles for the third straight day. On Sunday, he defeated Abilene Christian's Casper Steenkamp, 6-1, 6-3 and teamed with Guido Weidenfeld (Sr., Cologne, Germany) to defeat Jason Ray and Evan Puglia, 9-7.

Cal Poly Pomona also got a singles win from Weidenfeld, who defeated Ray at No. 3 singles, 6-3, 6-7 (10-8).

Azusa Pacific, meanwhile, swept the three doubles contests and won five of the six singles matches. Sam Fletcher won at No. 1 singles over Mike Chin, 6-1, 6-2. Fletcher and Adam Davidson won at No. 1 doubles, 8-6, over UC Davis' Kyle Trinosky and Ross Barasch. UC Davis picked up its lone point at No. 5 singles where Casey McMakin defeated Gordon Hung, 3-6, 6-1, (10-4).
