General Rules

1. The purpose of the Ag Ed Club Scholarship is to support its membership seeking a career in the Agricultural Education.
2. Who May Apply?
 - ❖ Any Agriculture Education Club member intending to teach high school agriculture,
 - ❖ Demonstrates a commitment to school and community; and
 - ❖ Supports the mission and activities of the Ag Ed Club.
3. Each applicant must prepare an application and supporting documents then submit three copies of completed package by May 3rd to:

4. Two \$250 scholarships may be awarded each year.
5. Each application package must:
 - ✓ Include a completed scholarship form.
 - ✓ Include a written statement of **no more than 200** words that include:
 - 1) Why you want to be an ag teacher,
 - 2) Why you qualify for an Ag Ed Club scholarship,
 - 3) How this scholarship will help you achieve your goals, and
 - 4) A statement about your direct personal contribution and investment toward becoming an agriculture teacher.
6. The recipients will be selected based on a 100 point scoring system as follows:
 - 1) Application packet (10points)
 - 2) Activities Record (35 points)
 - 3) Written Statement (55 points)Points will be awarded based on a subjective review of the applications by the scholarship committee. The committee may choose not to make an award if they feel packets are not up to a minimum threshold set prior to review of the packets.
7. The Ag Ed Club Scholarship Committee will make the final decisions on all applications and awards. Decisions are not subject to review.
8. The Ag Ed Club Scholarship Committee will be comprised of the Ag Ed Club Advisor and two Ag Ed Club Officer. In the event there two officers are not available to sit on the committee (i.e. they apply for the scholarship), the Ag Ed Club advisor will select an appropriate replacement to fill the committee.
9. Applicants may be asked by the committee to be interviewed.
