

INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS DEPARTMENT

SUPERVISED STUDY ("STUDY HALL")

Supervised Study is a mandatory block of study time for student-athletes who do not achieve a minimum academic standard as set forth by the Intercollegiate Athletics Department. Supervised Study will have a coordinator who will report to the Academic Counselor. He/she will be a qualified Mathematics tutor who is capable of tutoring most levels of college mathematics at Cal Poly Pomona. The coordinator will also complete nightly and weekly reports of attendance and behavior during the study sessions.

The Head Coach from each team has the discretion to mandate any student-athletes' attendance at Supervised Study. The department standard for mandatory attendance at Supervised Study is a cumulative Cal Poly or Overall grade point average below a 2.5. **All student-athletes with a cumulative Cal Poly or Overall GPA below a 2.5 will be required to complete a minimum of four (4) hours of Supervised Study per week.** Supervised Study will be held in the Learning Resource Center (LRC), Bldg. 15 Room 4. The LRC is located on the ground floor of the library.

Supervised Study will begin the Second (2nd) week of the quarter and is open Monday through Thursday from 6-pm to 9-pm. Student-athletes must log all study hours during the designated time schedule. Student-Athletes who are unable to attend the designated study time and need to schedule alternate study sessions must meet with the Academic Counselor to make alternate arrangements. The LRC may be able to accommodate some student-athletes completing study hours during the day, but these students must first get permission from the academic counselor. Student-Athletes who do not complete four (4) hours of supervised study in a given week, will be held accountable for making up the missed hours as well as the following:

- **1st Offense in a quarter** – The student-athlete will be called in for an individual meeting with the Academic Counselor to discuss the reason for not completing the 4 hours of study and explain the consequences if subsequent study sessions are not completed.
- **2nd Offense in a quarter** – Individual meeting with the Athletic Director and Head Coach for disciplinary action, which minimally entails immediate suspension from practice and/or competition until missed study time is made up.

Note: Consequences for missed Supervised Study during the off-season may be implemented during the next regular season of practice and competition.

The Intercollegiate Athletics Department is committed to academic and athletic excellence. The Supervised Study program will assist student-athletes who have not shown responsible decision-making skills in regard to their academic endeavors by prioritizing their academic and athletic involvement at Cal Poly Pomona.
