Open to all students with a cumulative GPA above 2.8 who will be Juniors or Seniors during the next academic year (AY 2007-2008).

Selected undergraduates at the junior/senior level can earn up to \$1,340 per academic quarter and \$3,600 during the summer working on a research project sponsored by one or more faculty researchers at Cal Poly Pomona. Additional funding for research supplies and travel will be available. No previous research experience is required.
