

Dear Cal Poly Pomona Student,

We are all feeling the budget crunch, but your education is the College's first priority. We will do everything in our power to help you get through with as little disruption to your education as possible at Cal Poly Pomona.

We will be adding courses based on demonstrated demand. If you cannot register for a class you need, please consider the following:

- 1) Develop a back-up plan if the classes you want aren't available Fall Quarter. Remember that most areas of GE can be satisfied with several different courses.
- 2) Some courses do not have to be taken in the Fall Quarter, for example if they are not part of a three-quarter sequence. We will be offering many courses again in the Winter and Spring Quarters. Check with your advisor or the department offering the course about options.
- 3) If there is a course that you must have and there are no available seats, you must register your interest in the course by adding your name to a demand list. This list is available in the department office of the department that offers the course. Please note that adding your name to the list will not guarantee that you will be added the course, even if additional sections of the course are opened. You should check Bronco Direct frequently so that you can add the course you need as additional seats become available. Contact your Department Chair if you run into difficulty, and remember that the Dean's Office is always open to you.
