The Wang Family Excellence Awards were established in 1998 to recognize and celebrate those CSU faculty and administrators who, through extraordinary commitment and dedication, have distinguished themselves by exemplary contributions and achievements in their academic disciplines or appropriate areas of university assignment. Through a gift of \$1,000,000 to The California State University by Trustee Stanley T. Wang, each year for ten years, four faculty members and one administrator will be honored and each honoree will receive \$20,000.

Nominations are being solicited from the campus in both the faculty and administrator categories. Two campus selection committees (one for faculty nominees and another for administrator nominees) will review the campus applications and recommend to the President the nominations to be forwarded to the Office of the Chancellor. A nominee should be regarded as a "super star" on their campus; the systemwide selection committee is looking for individuals who are making multi-faceted contributions to the learning community, for example, involving students in research, arranging and supervising student internships, involvement in community service, recruiting students, and publishing; and, successful nominees should go well beyond what is expected for their job responsibilities and performance.

Awards will be made to those who have made truly remarkable contributions to the advancement of their respective universities and/or the CSU system. Nominees should have a demonstrated record of unusually meritorious achievements documented by evidence of superior accomplishments and contributions to the discipline or achievements in an assignment. The activities must advance the mission of the university, bring benefit and credit to the CSU, and contribute to the enhancement of the CSU's excellence in teaching, learning, research, scholarly pursuits, student support and community contributions.

Faculty members nominated for the award must be probationary or tenured (this includes FERP faculty members) and must have participated successfully in a campus peer-academic administrative review process such as the RTP process, post-tenure review, research or scholarship grant processes, and the like. These reviews must have occurred no earlier than the 2006-07 academic year.

case, the candidate should be involved in preparing the nomination materials.

## **ADMINISTRATOR CATEGORY**

Any administrator/manager who currently serves in the management personnel plan (MPP) as an Administrator III or IV on a campus or in the Chancellor's Office may apply. To be eligible for the award, the administrator/manager's record of performance, activities, accomplishments cited must occur after January 1, 2006. Only one administrator may be nominated per campus. Wang Family Excellence Awards recognize those who have made truly remarkable contributions to the advancement of their respective universities and/or the CSU system. Nominees should have a demonstrated record of unusually meritorious achievements documented by evidence of superior accomplishments in an assignment.
