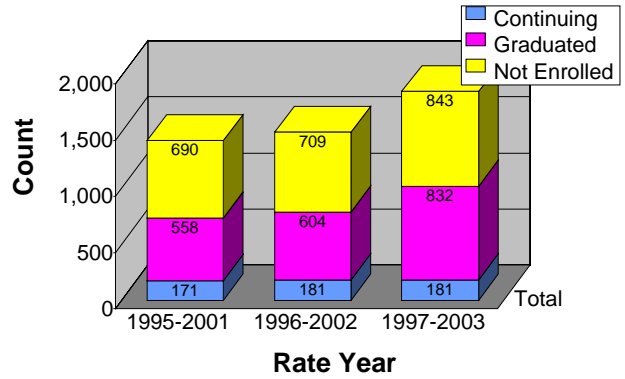


Full-Time, First-Time Freshmen Six-Year Persistence Rates Cohorts 1995 through 1997 by Gender

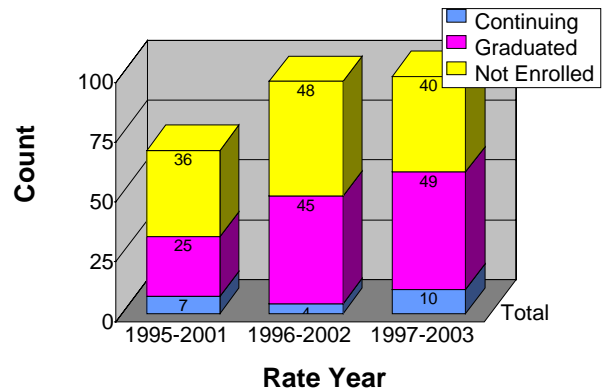

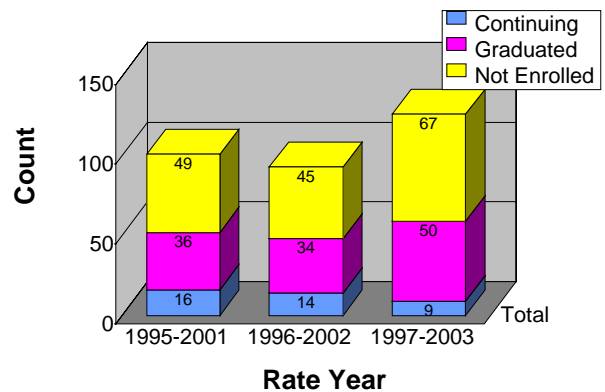
