## Services

The Stop Violence Office is an office on-campus that addresses sexual assault, domestic/dating violence, and stalking aiming to reduce intimate crimes on campus through education, training, survivor advocacy and support services.

## Context of Issue

In-class presentations on sexual assault are conducted year round due to the following statistics:

- 20%-25% of college aged women are raped or someone will attempt to rape them during their undergraduate years (DOJ 2005).
- Teenagers and young adults are at greatest risk for date rape (DOJ 2006).
- 1 out of 3 women will be sexually assaulted in their lifetime
- 1 out of 4 young adults are in a violent relationship.

The in-class presentations are provided as a preventative measure in addition to providing referral information to those students in need of advocacy and crisis intervention.

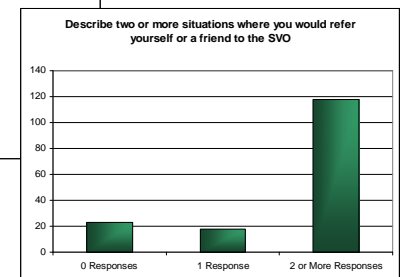
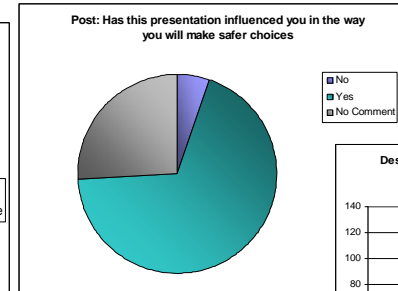
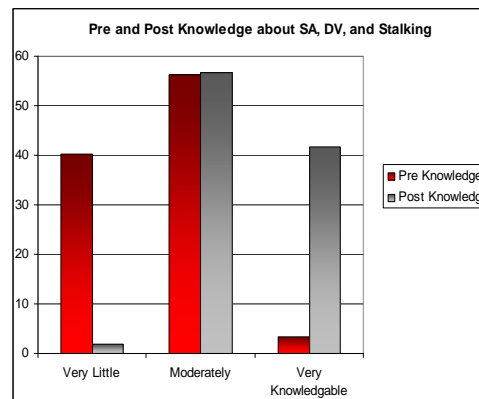
## Method

Data was collected through pre/post test administered to 211 students during four in-class presentations. Pre/Post test measure:

- Level of knowledge regarding sexual assault before/after Location of SVO
- Student awareness of situations where SVO can offer assistance
- Student influenced to make safer dating choices after presentation

The SVO will continue to collect data during in-class presentations through pre/post test. Feedback provided through assessment will be used to enhance SVO in-class presentations. Based on student feedback the SVO will continue to:
