### How do I find articles about the Hospitality industry?

*Hospitality and Tourism Complete* **database** 500,000 records from more than 500 titles; worldwide.

This is **now a full-text** database! Use the **Find IT! link** for any citations that do not have a **full-text icon**.

#### *ABI/Inform* **database**

Strong coverage of hospitality subjects. And mostly full text. Use the **Find IT! Link**.

#### Factiva **database**

Not linked to Find It! but mostly full text. See instructions for searching in *Business Subject Databases*. Broad, with worldwide, coverage.

#### *Snapshot Series North America* - **database**

Detailed online reports include Hospitality industries such as beverages, catering, hotels, etc. Search by subject or select the “Browse” tab, then the “By Industry” tab to see a listing of major industry groups. Open the “View Documents” link for the listing of individual reports. Open each for the **full text** of the report.

#### *Standard and Poor's Net Advantage* **database**

Select “Industries” at top. Surveys for: *Alcoholic Beverages, Foods and Non-alcoholic Beverages, Lodging and Gaming, and Restaurants*.
