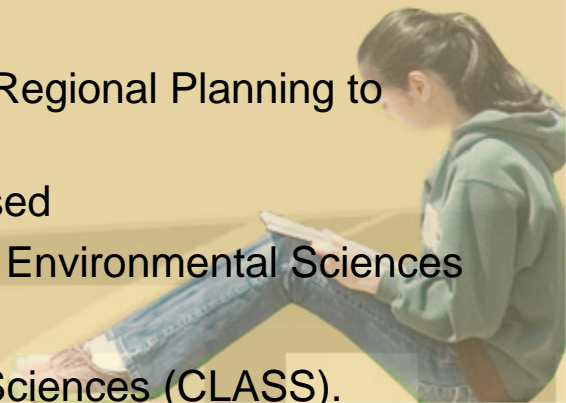
#1 The College of Agriculture is merged into the proposed College of Agricultural, Natural, and Environmental Sciences

#5 The Fine Art department is moved to the College of Letters, Arts and Social Sciences (CLASS).



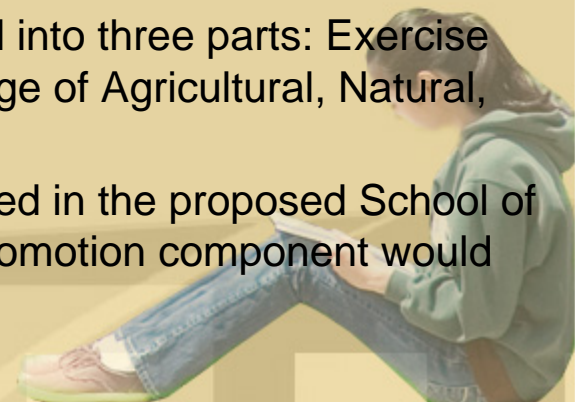

- #6 The College of Education and Integrative Studies (CEIS) would be reorganized into a proposed School of Education within CLASS.
- #7 Graphic Design is separated from the Fine Art program and moved as a stand-alone program into the College of Business Administration
- #8 The Public Relations portion of Communications will be moved from CLASS to the College of Business Administration Economics to be moved from CLASS to the College of Business Administration
- #9 The Kinesiology Program would be divided into three parts: Exercise Science would move to the proposed College of Agricultural, Natural, and Environmental Sciences.
- #10 The Pedagogy component would be placed in the proposed School of Education. Based on its size, the Health Promotion component would be eliminated.
