CRITERIA FOR ORAL PRESENTATION

Amount of Time: You will have **20-25 minutes** to present your assigned topic.

Assignment: You will present the assigned topic to the class, covering the following information:

1. Identify need of the topic – what is happening in the professional that is calling for more information on this topic?
2. Importance of the topic – why is this topic worth the time to research and present?
3. Relationship to management of programs – tie into the overall role of an APE teacher
4. Present current research – include articles, web search, and other relevant material.
5. Any other information that is relevant to the topic – include information that you want to that does not fit into the first 4 categories.

Presentation:

Oral presentation including videos, overheads, demonstrations, equipment, etc. (Anything that would help you to teach the topic to the class.) The oral presentation does not have to follow the exact order above but should cover the above information. You should not read to the class, but know your material well enough to present it in a professional manner.

Written presentation including handout or a copy of your power point presentation to the class that covers the 5 areas as stated above.

Evaluation: Total points (100) will be awarded if the presentation covers the above aspects in the allotted time.
