CRITERIA FOR CUSTOM CURRICULUM PROJECT (Worth 100 points)

Students will work in small groups to design and develop a curriculum to meet the specific needs of their teaching assignment.

The written curriculum project is worth 100 pts.

A summary presentation to the class is worth 50 pts.

- Develop a Curriculum for one school year:

Include the following components in your Curriculum

1. Cover Page (indicating age/grade level(s) selected)
2. Philosophy statement (appropriate for age level(s) selected)
3. Program Goal Statement(s)
4. Curriculum Map (Including PE Content Standards)
5. Organizational Format:
Calendars or outlines indicating units/activities presented throughout the year
6. Unit Plans for the school year
7. Include at least 3 lesson plans for each unit (Intro lesson; follow-up lesson; final/culminating lesson)
8. Citation of all references used.

Miscellaneous Information:

1. Use a notebook or binder to contain your curriculum project (No loose or stapled papers).
2. Footnote/cite all references (activities from texts, observations, verbal communication, etc.)
3. Projects must be typed (lesson plans may be written if clearly legible).
4. Curriculum project is due on Saturday, 05/10/08
