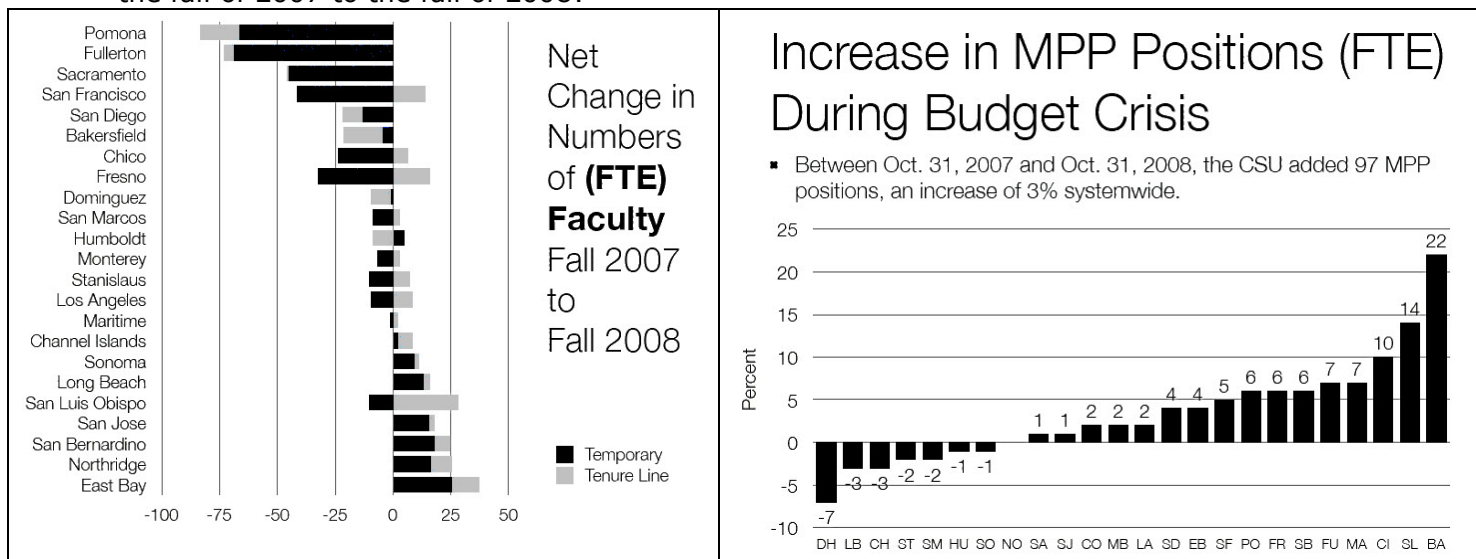
Report to the Academic Senate
