Registering for Winter Quarter 2008 Classes
Department of Urban and Regional Planning

Undergraduate Students

Core:

- **URP 461/462** sign ups will be Tuesday, January 8 at noon, 7-201.
- **URP 463 Senior Seminar.** This will be the last time the class is offered in this academic year, so if you are graduating in June, you need to take the Winter quarter.

Subcore electives:

- **URP 441 Field Work.** Unpaid internship course, attend sign up meeting for instructor approval.
- **URP 487 Environmental Factors in Regional Planning.** Class is offered on Saturdays.
- **URP 498 Advanced Planning Studio.** This course will be a community based physical design project.
- **URP 499 Diversity.** This class addresses diversity issues in planning.
- **URP 499 Dale Prize Seminar Class – Collaboration between Planning and Design Fields.** This class will study these relationships and have a special meeting with Dale Prize recipients.
- **URP 499/599 GIS.** Undergraduate students may take this as a *substitute* for URP 486.
- **URP 534 Urban Housing and Community Development.** Undergraduate students may seek the instructor's consent to add this class by petition if they have completed 135 units, have a GPA of 2.75 or better, and submit a petition to receive undergraduate credit for a graduate course by the end of the third week of class. This is a hybrid class.

- If you intend to take the comprehensive exam, you need to sign up for **URP 692** in the Winter. This course is a review and synthesis activity that is mandatory preparation for the Spring exam.
